Sterland Software's NuVu Reporting Suite Version 4.2 has just been released to the market and it includes some brilliant new features that make this already attractive tool a must-have for any company that's mindful of its business image.

Version 4.2's new features include allowing attachments to be attached to emails, auto blind copy every email, fax any document, direct output of report contents to formatted Excel spreadsheet, save files in PDF format from the NuVu viewer and allow flexible totaling of fields in the report.
